***For those new to Amateur Radio Nets; here are a few things to remember:**

- All licensed amateurs are welcome, no club membership is needed
- Emergency traffic has precedence over all other traffic
- Nets are informal, however following net control's guidance is generally expected
- "Short time Stations" are stations with limited time for the net
- "stations" are licensed amateur radio operators
- When you check into the net you will be given an opportunity to give your comments. Therefore to check in, give your callsign only and then wait to be acknowledged
- Your comments can be anything that is legal to say on the air
- If you are listening to the net on broadcastify or other means and are unable to transmit, you are welcome to check in with the net control station by other means (Facebook messenger, text or the like)
